The deadline for hotel reservations is August 1. If you think you will be attending, we suggest you make your reservations now. If you find you can't attend, you can cancel. Prices are good two days before and two days after the reunion.

Please be sure to fill out both forms completely and send them in. The information is used to make name badges, so please be sure all information, including spouse/guest names so we can have badges ready.

If you plan to go to the Canadian side of Niagara Falls, be sure to have a valid passport with you.

Notes:

- The Kitty (\$25) covers lunches and snacks on the Quarterdeck as well as alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks and paper goods. Lunch will be from noon to 1pm on Monday and Friday. We will be on tours Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.
- The price of Tuesday's tours (\$90) includes driver gratuity, tour guide and lunch with tip. The trip includes a boat ride on the Erie Canal and lunch in Lockport, NY and Niagara Falls. There will be a boat ride on the Maid of the Mist. Time permitting, we will visit Goat Island for other photo opportunities.
- The price of Wednesday's tours (\$28) includes driver gratuity and tickets to the museum. Lunch is on your own and not included in the price. In East Aurora, NY, we will visit the Made in USA Store and Viddlers 5 & 10 Cent Store. Lunch will be in Aurora. We will then go to North Tonawanda, NY to tour the Herschell Carousel Factory Museum.
- The price of Thursday's trip (\$62) includes tickets to both sites, driver gratuity and lunch with tip. The trip to the Buffalo Naval Park includes visits to USS Sullivans (destroyer), USS Little Rock (cruiser), USS Croaker (sub), and museum with lunch and memorial service. The lunch buffet will be served on the canopied fantail of the USS Little Rock. Then we will go on a tour of the Wilcox mansion, the site of the inauguration of Theodore Roosevelt following the assassination of President McKinley in Buffalo on Sept. 14, 1901.
